

COVID-19 Guidance for Audiences

dock10 is actively supporting the return of live audiences to recordings being made in its studios. However, your safety while attending our facilities is paramount and COVID-19 measures are in place in line with the latest guidelines from the UK Government, the NHS and the World Health Organisation.

Current guidelines, supported by the major broadcasters, allows you to join unsocially distanced audiences only if you do not have any Covid-19 symptoms, are not required to be in isolation and have an NHS COVID Pass (card or app) or meet any of the following criteria:

- You have been double vaccinated for at least 14 days and can demonstrate this by showing a valid [NHS Covid Pass](#)
- You have tested negative in the last 48 hours and can demonstrate this by showing the relevant test record on the [NHS App report](#)
- You have had covid within the last 180 days and can demonstrate this by showing a positive PCR test recorded on the NHS App 10-180 days before attending the recording.

On arrival at dock10, you will be asked to wait outside the building before being guided to the studio wearing a mask. Masks must be worn in all dock10 corridors and communal areas and although our studios have excellent ventilation you may be required to wear a mask for the studio recording itself.

dock10 has no direct communication with audiences. It is the production company's responsibility to advise you of the specific safety procedures for your recording. Each production is responsible for its own audience management so you may be asked to do things differently each time you visit - please follow the instructions on your tickets and booking information.

Please note that audience access to dock10's studios is subject to change without notice and you may be refused access for your own safety and that of others.
